Programme

11.45am Mihi Whakatau

David O'Connell provided a mihi whakatau to Te Herekiekie Herewini who r esponded accordingly. The mihi whakatau was followed by lunch.

1.00pm Hui a rohe Presentation

Te Herekiekie provided a presentation to the Ngāi Tahu rūnanga representatives.

The presentation included:

- a) an update about the programme;
- b) what has been achieved by the programme both internationally and domestically since its establishment in 2003;
- c) discussion of unprovenanced koiwi tangata; and
- d) final resting place for unprovenanced köiwi tangata, which included principles of selecting a suitable resting place, and also the two options being taken around the country (i) a putunga kotahi and (ii) Te Rerenga Wairua.

Summary of the views expressed by the group

Ngāi Tahu had their own Te Rerenga Wairua in the past.

It is important to note there are unprovenanced kōiwi tangata in South Island Museums, however, this is matter that will be considered by these Museums and the respective iwi and hapu in due course.

Support for the principles of selecting a final resting place, however, the cost of providing a national wahi tapu should be met by the crown.

Do the kōiwi tangata need to be buried immediately, as science and technology in the near future may help in provenancing kōiwi tangata.

General support for the Ngāti Kuri tono, and for unprovenanced kōiwi tangata going to Te Rerenga Wairua as a final resting place.

The work of the Te Papa's repatriation programme was appreciated.
