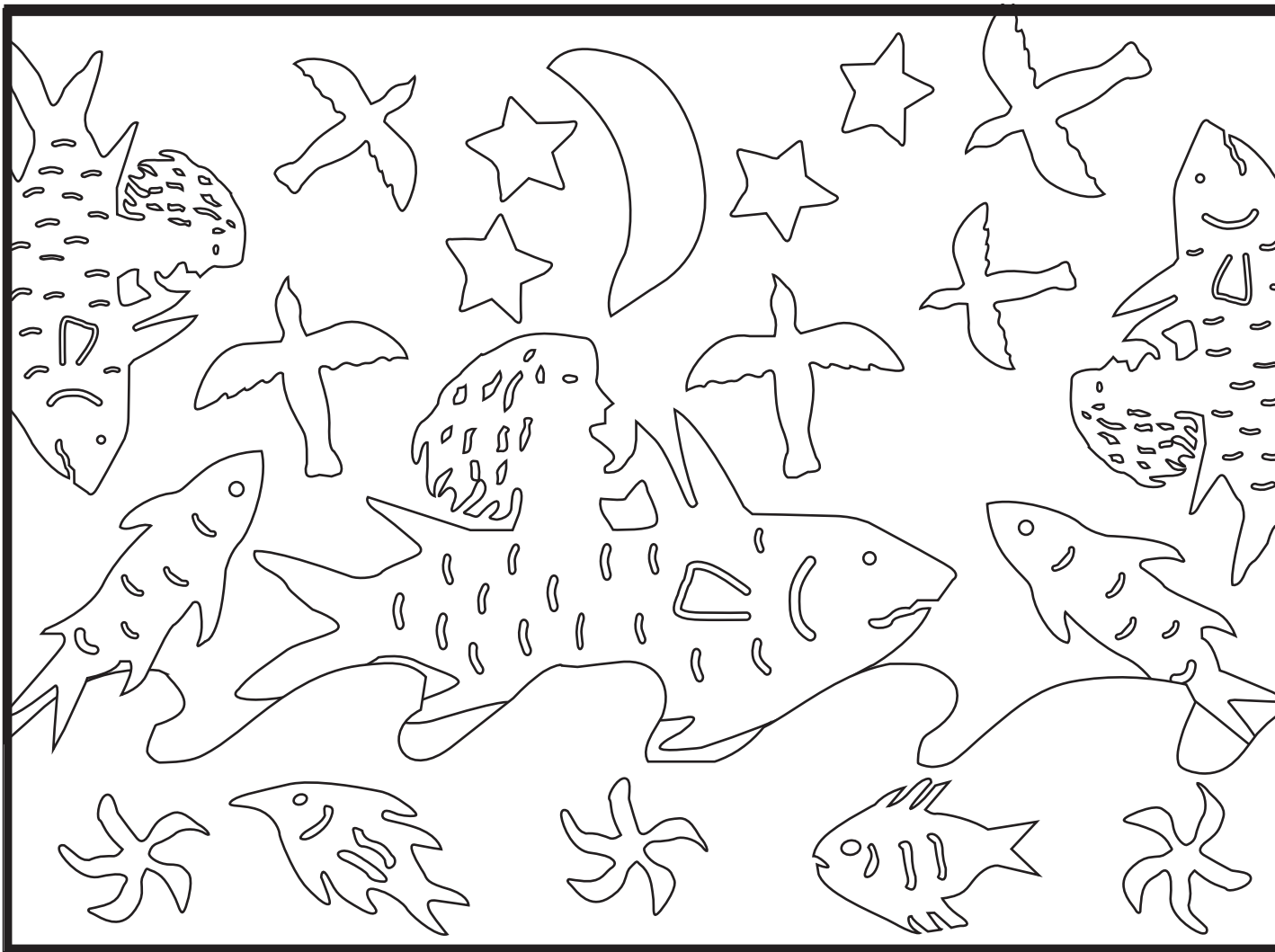

Tīvaevae 'Ina and the shark' (quilt), circa 1990

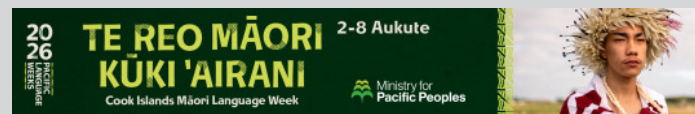
